The Cincinnati Region of the SCCA is happy to present the inaugral SCCA Club Race at the National Corvette Museum Motorsport Park. The facility was opened for limited events in August 2014. As such, the infrastructure of the facility is still under development. We have worked with the track management to be able to put on this event and make your experience as enjoyable as possible. But we ask you to be patient as we and the track learn how to work together. Where infrastructure is not in place, temporary facilities and work-around plans are being developed. For this event in June, the track, including all safety barriers, paved paddock, garages, tech area, restrooms with showers are planned to be completed. We will be working with temporary facilities for Registration and the Control Tower. The fuel station should be complete, but if not, fuel will be available (check back to the Cincy Region website as the event approaches for our list of available fuels.

We will be running the Grand Course – 3.15 miles with some very exciting features. Since most have not had the opportunity to drive this track, we will be having a Practice Day on Friday where you can get some track time and we hope to have some classroom coaching sessions throughout the day.

Camping will be available within self contained units in the paddock. There will be limited areas available for tent camping. There will be a track charge for camping, except for volunteer workers. Again, more information will be available on the Cincy website as it becomes available. The track also has partner hotels in the area with negotiated rates.

We are working with the area's visitor bureau to pull together information on area attractions for those who want to spend time away from the track. If everyone will have a little patience as we work through the many challenges this new facility poses to us, we will guarantee all the members of the Cincinnati Region will do everything possible to make your visit to this new facility a memorable experience.
