### 2012 SCCA National Convention

Just some quick notes from the SCCA National Convention in Las Vegas.

#### **Annual Meeting**

- Insurance liability rates flat but car counts were down, resulting in modest insurance increases. Plan to request quotes for both blanket and for each discipline separately next year.
- SCCA Inc. had Net Income of \$55k. Membership down 3.4% to 40,388.
- SCCA Pro had Net Loss of \$20k. Discontinuing Pro SRF and Pro FE due to lack of sponsorship. Adding F1000 as a new series with 20 drivers signed on. F2000/1600 adding an Atlantic Champ Series.
- SCCA Enterprises revenue up 6.5% to \$1.8M. Net Income \$14k. Loan balance to SCCA Inc under \$380k.
- SCCA Foundation supported 27 Street Survival events (down 15%) by 19 regions (up 72%) with 524 students.
- Treasurer report indicated Sanction income down \$50k, Licensing income down \$15k.
- Jeff Dahnert reported National races 68 in 2010, 74 in 2011, and project 85 in 2012. Engaging Trozzolo Communications Group to manage SCCA branding and look at where motorsports will be in 5 years.
- 2012 Steward's Manual re-write should be available on website file cabinet. Adding a Guest Steward program oriented at providing cross exposure between drivers and SOM. Continuing Ground School program for SIT's.
- ACCUS is proposing to form an LLC with SCCA, IMSA, and USAC presidents on the board to liason F1 events in US. Expect SCCA to be involved in Austin event.

Majors Program is being trialed in western divisions. Program is still morphing so it is subject to change. Regions can opt-in. Showcase Bonus races (2/3 classes serving 36% of participants). Invitational races (Top 1/3 classes serving 64% of participants). Will probably be 4 zones across country (my guess would be CenDiv, GLD and MiDiv together). Top 10 classes will likely be different in each zone. Planning Invitational races to be 2-race weekend, Sunday qualifying race, 3 sessions per day, 2 classes per group, split starts, time specific schedule, and 20-26 minute sessions.
