This will be the 10th edition of the IT/SPEC*tacular, the region's main Club Race. The concept of the IT/SPEC*tacular was born in 2007 in an effort to address the potential of non-profitabe events in the declining economy. The approach was to give grassroots racers a venue to race, while maintaining a potential for a positive profit. So the IT/SPEC*tacular was born in which the Improved Touring and the popular Spec classes were invited to a restricted double regional event that featured a three race format for crowning a champion in each class. This format was well received by the invited classes and the event was a success, allowing the region to continue to host events. As the economy improved and racers started coming back to events, the region expanded the event back to include all SCCA classes, and was re-badged as the IT/SPEC*tacular Plus. The 2016 edition of the IT/SPEC*tacular promises to be a great event, and we hope you will join us in August at Mid-Ohio.

The facility is located in central Ohio just west of Interstate I-71. Note referenced distances are approximate. Please mind your speed so you don't contribute to the local economy. Also, watch for horse drawn buggies on the local roadways.

2016 SCHEDULE

August 5, 2016 – Friday PERFORMANCE DRIVING EXPERIENCE (PDX)

The Cincinnati Region is happy to again offer an SCCA sanctioned track day in conjunction with the IT/SPEC*tacular weekend. Detail information and schedule can be found in the PDX Supplemental Rules, but the fundamental event is an opportunity for those without any competition license to experience driving the Mid-Ohio Sports Car Course in their own vehicle. Classroom sessions will give you the fundamentals, which will be augmented with on-track sessions for more detail instruction. Experience instructors will ride along and give you real-time instruction and feedback.

August 5, 2016 – Friday – DAYTIME TEST AND TUNE

Anticipating racers wanting to have some serious time for tweaking themselves and/or their car for the weekend races and/or the SCCA Championship Runoffs in September, we are making available a Daytime Test and Tune for Club Racers entered in the IT/SPEC*tacular. All classes will be combined into one of four groups, and each group will have a 20-minute session in the morning, and a 20-minute session in the afternoon. This schedule will actually allow time for drivers to analyze data and make adjustments between sessions. Groups will be limited to the first 65 entries.

August 5, 2016 - Friday - MEET-N-GREET SOCIAL

The Cincinnati Region members would like to invite everyone in attendance (drivers, crew, guests, volunteer workers, track employees) to join us for some socializing curtesy of our event sponsors. Beverages and light snacks will be provided. Location and time will be posted at Registration. So once you get settled into your paddock, come have a cold one and do some bench racing with your friends. We will also be remembering Cincinnati Region members who have passed on in the past year with a memorial toast.

August 5, 2016 – Friday – TWILIGHT OPEN TEST AND TUNE

On Friday evening, The Mid-Ohio School will hold a Twilight OpenTest and Tune typically from 5:00 PM until 8:30 PM. Information and registration are available on their website at www.midohio.com/school/courses . Note that this is not a Cincinnati Region or SCCA sanctioned event.

August 6, 2016 – Saturday – IT/SPEC*tacular CLUB RACING

Saturday starts with a 20-minute qualifying session for each of seven groups. Grid spots for the qualifying session will be determined by each entries' registration date/time, so register early. We operate on a "no schedule" schedule starting at 8:00 AM and rotate through each group with a short clean-up period between each session. Listen to the PA announcements for your group. The qualifying will be followed with our first race of the weekend for each goroup. Race 1 will be a 14 lap race with Grid positions determined by the morning qualifying times. We anticipate running Group 1's Race 1 before lunch. Listen to PA announcements for your call to Grid.

August 6, 2016 - Saturday - WORKER/OFFICIAL SOCIAL DINNER

In an effort to contain costs associated with catering at Mid-Ohio, the Cincinnati Region will not be hosting a Saturday Social/Dinner as in the past. Lake Erie Communications will be hosting a

dinner in the LEC Camping area for all volunteer workers and officials. Worker gifts/donations from the drivers and sponsors will be awarded at this event.

August 7, 2016 – Sunday – IT/SPEC*tacular CLUB RACING

Club Racing continues with two races for each of the seven groups. Race 2 will be a 9-lap race run in the morning. Grid positions will be determined by the best lap time run in Saturday's Race 1. Race 3 will be a 12-lap race. Grid positions will be set by participant's finishing position in the Sunday Race 2. We anticipate running Group 1's Race 3 before lunch. Again, listen to PA announcements for your call to Grid.

EVENT CHAMPIONSHIP AND TROPHIES

For each class, the top three finishers will be awarded an IT/SPEC*tacular Gold,Silver, or Bronze Medal for each of the three races. Participants will be awarded points for finishing position in each of the three races. The top three in points for each class will also be an overall Championship Trophy after Race 3.

PADDOCK

Paddock will utilize both paved and un-paved locations. Paved areas include the Lower Paved Paddock (with garages), Middle Paved Paddock, and possibly the Upper Paved Paddock. Un-paved areas are located to the South of the Paved Paddocks.

GARAGE RENTAL

A limited number of garages will be available to rent. There are single-door garages (Numbers 2-6, and 21-28) and two-door garages (Number 7- 20). Garages can be rented at the time you register by specifying the type of garage and preference of number. Maximum rental period is from Thursday (August 4) at 6:00 PM until Sunday (August 7) at 5:00 PM.

FUEL/AIR/WATER

Track fuel is available on-site at the fuel pumps located at the East side of the Middle Paddock. Pumps are self-serve by credit card. Compressed air and water is located at the fuel pumps. Compressed air and water is also available throughout the rented garages.

STAYING AT THE TRACK

Camping will be permitted on Thursday through Saturday nights only. The camping area is limited to the paddock for drivers/crew and Lake Erie Communications Camping for volunteer workers. Motor home, 5-wheel, camper trailers and other "self-contained units" may be assessed a \$30 weekend camping fee by Mid-Ohio. This does not include volunteer workers. All other forms of camping are free. Mid-Ohio has a self-serve dump station available for those paying the weekend fee.

TRACK RULES

Just some of Mid-Ohio Rules you should be aware of in order for everyone to have a pleasant/safe visit to the facility. See Event Supplemental Rules for complete rules.

- 1. No pets allowed on the facility property at any time.
- 2. Everyone on-site must sign the SCCA or Mid-Ohio Waiver.
- 3. Bicycles, skates, Razors, scooters, hoover-boards, and skateboards (with or w/o motor) are prohibited by Mid-Ohio.
- 4. 16, and 17 year old drivers are required to contact Tammi Grffith (Mid-Ohio) at tgriffith@midohio.com or 800-643-6446 X-3007 for copies of Mid-Ohio's Minor Waiver (this is in addition to the SCCA Minor Waiver). These must be obtained well in advance & require a Notary Public's signature. The completed Mid-Ohio waiver and information must be returned to Mid-Ohio prior to the event per the Mid-Ohio policy. Mid-Ohio does not allow 15 year old drivers.
- 5. Paddock speed limit is 10 MPH. Anyone operating ANY motorized vehicle on the track property must have a valid driver's license (any state).
- 6. Fuel spillage on any paved area of the facility is forbidden and may result in a black flag and liability for repairs if instructions from any officials are not obeyed promptly. Jack stand bases must be supported so as to avoid pavement indentations.
- 7. No unmuffled engines may be operated between 7 PM and 7 AM unless traveling to or from Tech.
- 8. Minimum age in the pits is 18 years. Sleeved shirts, long pants, and closed shoes are required in the pits. Credentials must be clearly visible at all times.
- The infield will be OPEN to spectators. No trash is permitted; everything you carry in must be carried out. (GRANDSTANDS CLOSED)
- 10. Sale of any products on Mid-Ohio property is strictly prohibited without prior written permission from Mid-Ohio.
- 11. Please use the provided receptacles for trash, oil, and other fluids. Do not leave any tires at the track, except with tire vendors.
- 12. You will be required to vacate the premises by 6:30 PM Sunday. If later, you will be billed for the cost of Security.
- 13. Aerial remotely-controlled vehicles are not permitted without prior written permission from Mid-Ohio.
