Speaker, David Thompson-SCCA member and President of New Driver Car Control Clinic, spoke about their upcoming Toyota Car Control Challenge being held in four locations throughout greater Cincinnati. Students write an online Attitude essay and take a Knowledge Test to <code>ualify</code>. Up to 500 <code>ualifiers</code> will participate in the Skills test and compete for <code>10,000</code> and a Toyota Matrix grand <code>pri\_e</code> as well as several <code>1,000</code> <code>pri\_es</code>. David is asking our region to help with the judging at the Skills tests so here is your chance to participate in a very worthwhile program.

The standard Car Control Clinic, available at their local facility, provides handson, in-car training that consists of a 120-minute discussion of vehicle and human dynamics followed by four hours of in-car instruction in accident avoidance and defensive driving maneuvers. These programs include both the young driver and their parent stoto sharpen everyone skills.

#### Minutes of the April 15, 2008 Meeting of the Cincinnati Region Sports Car Club of America

Board members in attendance were Bill Niemeyer Jr., E.B. Lunken, Rick Barger, Chipp Swindler, Todd Cholmondeley, Jerry Cabe, Kurt Niemeyer, Doug Duddey, and Brian Walker. Also in attendance was Andy Stanford.

The meeting was called to order by Bill Niemeyer Jr.

On the motion of Jerry Cabe, with E.B. Lunken seconding, the minutes of the previous meeting were approved.

Rick Barger presented the treasurer's report. On the motion of Todd Cholmondeley, with Jerry Cabe seconding, the report was approved.

In old business, the board discussed the possibility of conducting in 2009, in addition to the I.T.Spec\*tacular, a road race at Bluegrass Road Course and Motorsports Club. On the motion of Rick Barger, with Chipp Swindler seconding, the board voted to request that Bluegrass reserve the weekend of May 16-17, 2009.

Brian Walker informed the board that the 2008 Cincinnati British Car & Motor Bike Show will be July13, in Fairfield.

The board discussed the possibility of using color print for the "CinChronizer", and the issue of rates for commercial advertising. Jerry Cabe has a rate proposal that he will forward to Jill Tomey.

In the solo report, Andy Stanford told the board that the solo committee would like to add two events for this year, proving that suitable venues can be secured. The next event is a joint one with WOR, June 8.

Todd Cholmondeley gave the race report. He distributed to the board a draft of the supps, which he hopes to have approved by June 1. He also told the board that Hoosier Tire had agreed to a contingency award program for the race, agreeing to sponsor all classes but SRF which uses a spec tire. Hoosier will provide four tires to each class winner, and two to each second place finisher. The test and tune session that Mid-Ohio is conducting following the PDX will have one open wheel class and two closed wheel classes. The cost has been lowered to \$150 for three 20-minute sessions for each class. Kurt Niemeyer told the board that he has received 10 commitments for the PDX.

In new business, Bill Niemeyer Jr. told the board that the Great Lakes Division is looking for a site for the Roundtable, and is considering a division convention to include solo, rally, and road racing.

On the motion of Rick Barger, with E.B. Lunken seconding, the meeting was adjourned.


