OVR held a 1-hour Enduro on Saturday in which Paul Russ drove his SRF to 5<sup>th</sup> overall and 5<sup>th</sup> in class. For the 10-lap Handicap Race on Sunday, I finished 7<sup>th</sup> overall, but 1<sup>st</sup> in class.

The Grand Am and Continental Tire Challenge series came to Mid-Ohio for the season finale during September 16-18<sup>th</sup>. Invited to participate in this large spectator event was the SCCA with an IT-Spec Miata Shootout. Registration for this event was 48 with about half being SM's. We had practice on Friday, qualifying on Saturday, and then three races on Sunday (a 13 lap and a 15 lap qualifying race, followed by a 19 lap race). There was a lot of top talent from around the GLD and other divisions in attendance. In Spec Miata, Dan Ruggiero and I participated from Cincinnati Region. Dan did well, qualifying 13<sup>th</sup>, and finishing 10<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> overall in the races (finishing 2<sup>nd</sup> in SM in the final race). I felt I did OK after starting with a very poor 42<sup>nd</sup> place qualifying, followed by a 37<sup>th</sup>, 38<sup>th</sup> and a 32<sup>nd</sup> place overall (finishing 18<sup>th</sup> in class in the final race out of 25 SM's). Volunteers working this Pro event from the Cincy Region were too numerous for me to list, but I'm sure they all had a great time. Several of the corner workers waved to me, usually with their blue flags.

The next race in the GLD was the Ohio Valley Sprints, put on by OVR on October 8-9<sup>th</sup> at Mid-Ohio. This is a double-regional event which runs the 2.4 mile Club Course on Saturday, and then switches to the 2.258 mile Pro Course on Sunday. They also run a 1-hour Enduro on Saturday, and a 10-lap Handicap race on Sunday.
