Steve Jenks in Formula Mazda. Steve qualified 3rd with a 2:15.946 and finished 4th. **Tom Patton in GT-2 in his Tiger.** Tom qualified 3rd with a 2:18.797 and finished 2nd. **David Doran in S2000.** David qualified 9th with a 2:23.443 but only finished 5 laps, scoring a DNF. **Shawn Slattery in Spec Miata.** Shawn qualified 7th with a 2:44.487 and finished 11th in his 1990 Miata (reported underdog to the 1999 Miatas).

William Niemeyer, Jr. in STU. Bill qualified 10th with a 2:37.774 and finished 10th.

Also attending in volunteer positions were Bob Cowie (F&C), Wayne Briggs, Jason Briggs, EB Lunken, and Barney Powers (Sound), and John Peterson (SOM). Race Report

The race committee met on October 4th to discuss the possibility of running a spring PDX, and to hammer out details of the Cincinnati I.T.SPEC*tacular for 2012. Mid Ohio is unwilling to rent the track for a single Saturday after April 1st which would mean a March date for a PDX. This seemed a little too risky to the committee. It was decided that we would approach Western Ohio Region to see if they would be interested in sharing a PDX day with their projected May double regional.

As for the I.T.SPEC*tacular. While Mid Ohio will not have firm dates until after Thanksgiving the date we are asking for is still "safe". Safe being that no pro group has asked for it. A questionnaire has been sent out to all the PDX participants over the past three years asking for feedback on future PDX's. Data is still being gathered and a final report will be issued at the November 7th race committee meeting. On the racing side SCCA pro has been contacted to see if the feasibility of running F2000 and F1600 series as part of our event is possible. The initial response from SCCA pro has been positive. Also a grassroots effort has formed the Improved Touring National Tour. They are in the process of building a website and rules package and plan to kick off the 2012 campaign at the ARRC in November. The I.T.SPEC*tacular will be a major stop on the tour next year. Next Race/PDX committee meeting will be November 7th at 7pm at Pomodori's 7880 Remington Rd., Montgomery Ohio 45242.
